We have appreciated the opportunity to bring our expertise to the Minister's Advisory Council, consulting on the development of the new CYSN Framework. BCACDI agrees with the values underpinning the Framework's development: Accessibility, Inclusion, Strengths and Needs Based, Quality, and Indigenous Led and Focused. The Framework's proposed network of multi-service hubs with a consistent suite of programs and services to support children, youth, and families regardless of diagnosis or circumstance matches the vision of BCACDI. In order for the operationalization of this framework to be successful, considerable stakeholder engagement is still required and must also be accompanied with increased investments into the sector to ensure equitable access to family-centered services with the flexibility and innovation to best meet the needs of all children, youth and families in BC.
